Delaware County 2024 Trail Update

Since 2019, the Trail Grant Program has funded eleven projects in five communities. The Delaware County Trail Committee has also written support letters for numerous other projects in the county. DCRPC staff continues to keep the parks, trails, and sidewalk information updated throughout the area. This information has been critical in gaining outside funding for Active Transportation projects and planning for future projects.









Rome Corners at Township Hall

A small connection was funded, providing for future connectivity to the Berkshire Township Hall and Park.

Cheshire Road near Sourcepoint

Filled a gap that was difficult to complete given the project needed to cross land in both Liberty Township and the City of Delaware. Glenross, Cheshire Crossing, Sourcepoint, and other locations are now connected.

Sunbury Library Trail and Fallen Heroes

Connects the Fallen Heroes Memorial Park and Sunbury Community Library south through Sun Valley Park. Developers have provided additional connectivity to new sections of Sunbury Meadows.

North Road

Right-of-way for the filling of gaps that could not be completed when development initially took place. Trail has since been completed.

Home Road from 315 to Perry Road

Segment provides connectivity from the Trail's End subdivision at S.R. 315 to Perry Road, providing safe travel for many on-road cyclists crossing Home Road from Taggart Road to Perry Road.

Lewis Center Trail near Alum Creek Park

Part of an east/west route across the county, connects the Alum Creek Beach area to The Shores and Parkshore neighborhoods, down Lewis Center to Bale-Kenyon Road.

Home Road Gap

Completed a small gap between Concord, Powell, and Liberty Twp.

Library Trail Pedestrian Crossing

Hawk light at the north end of Golf Village, providing safer crossing to an Elementary school.

Green Meadows Drive Gap

Completed a connection along Green Meadows Drive near the Orange Pointe business park.
