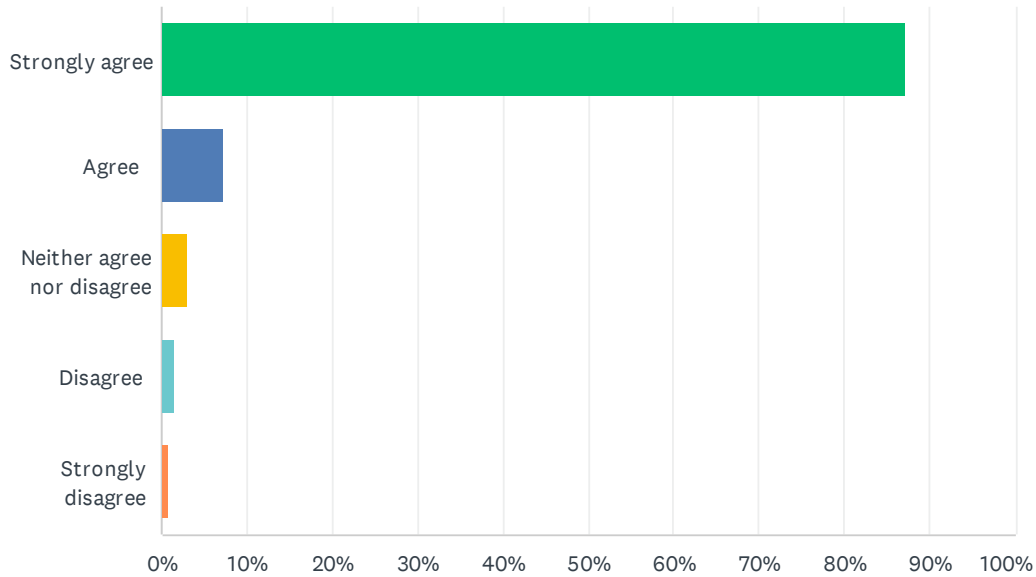


# Q1 I enjoy the rural character, small town feeling of our township, defined by low densities, agriculture, and undeveloped areas.

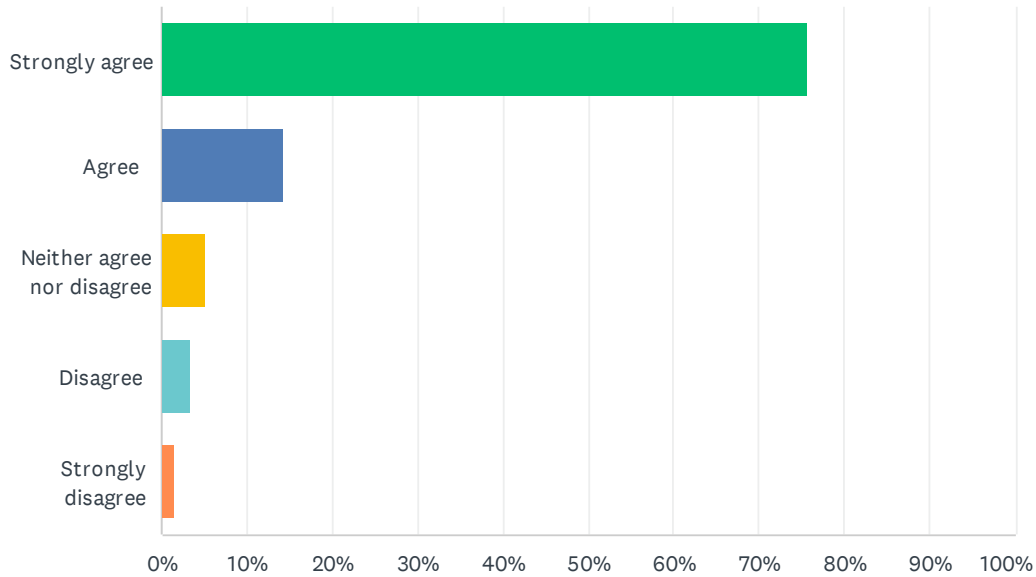

## Q2 I prefer local, small government as opposed to bigger government with more services at a greater cost.

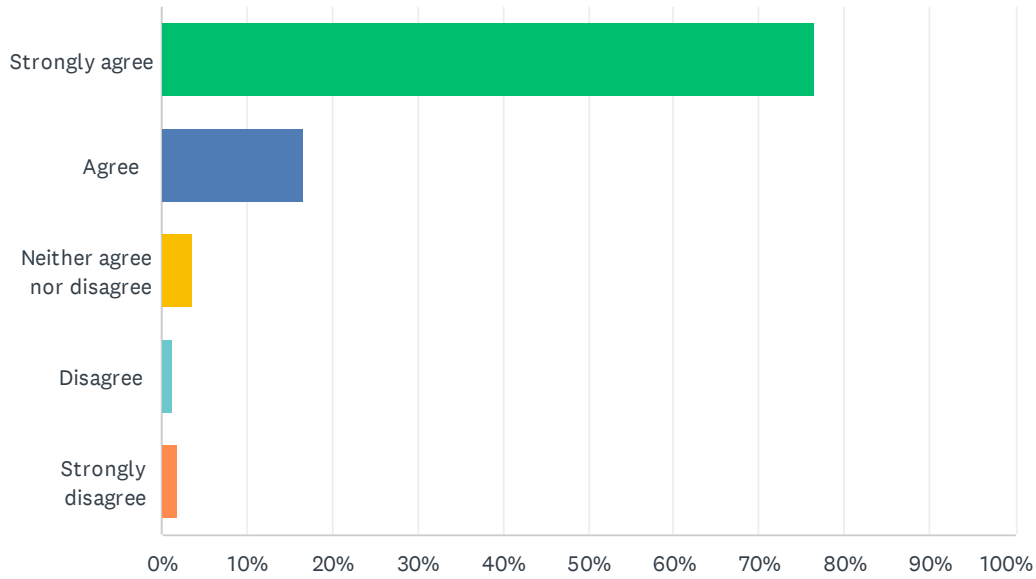

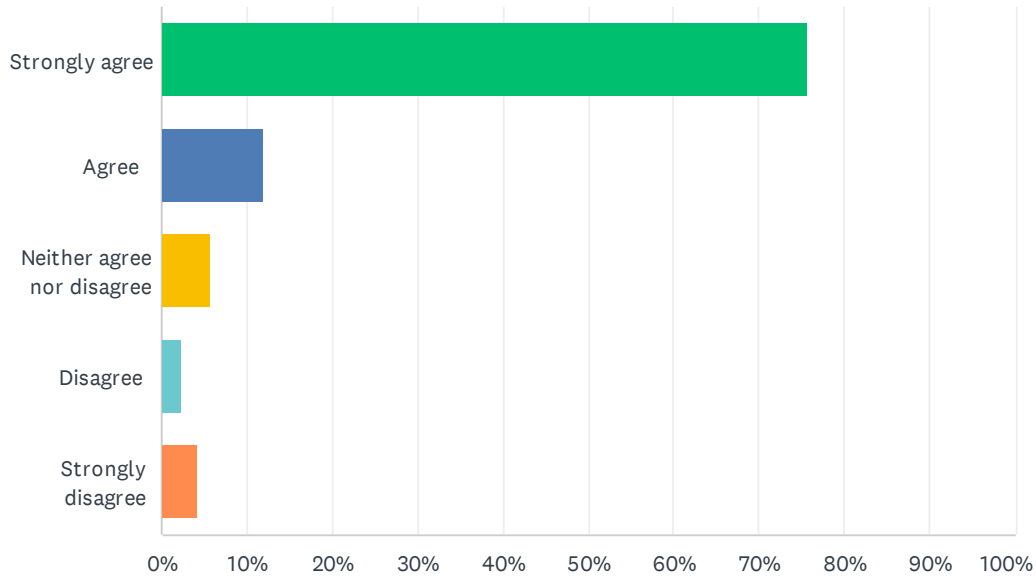

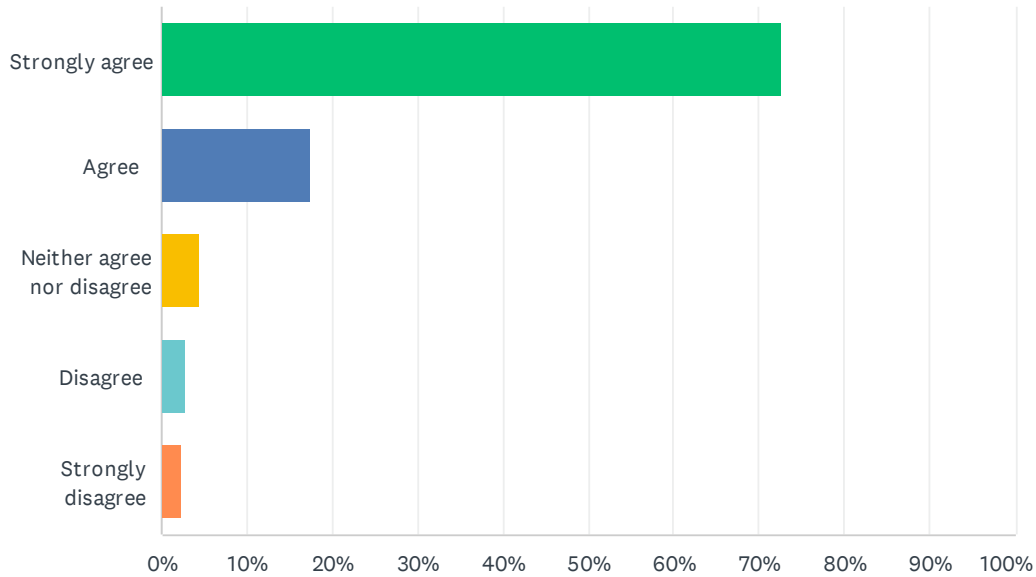

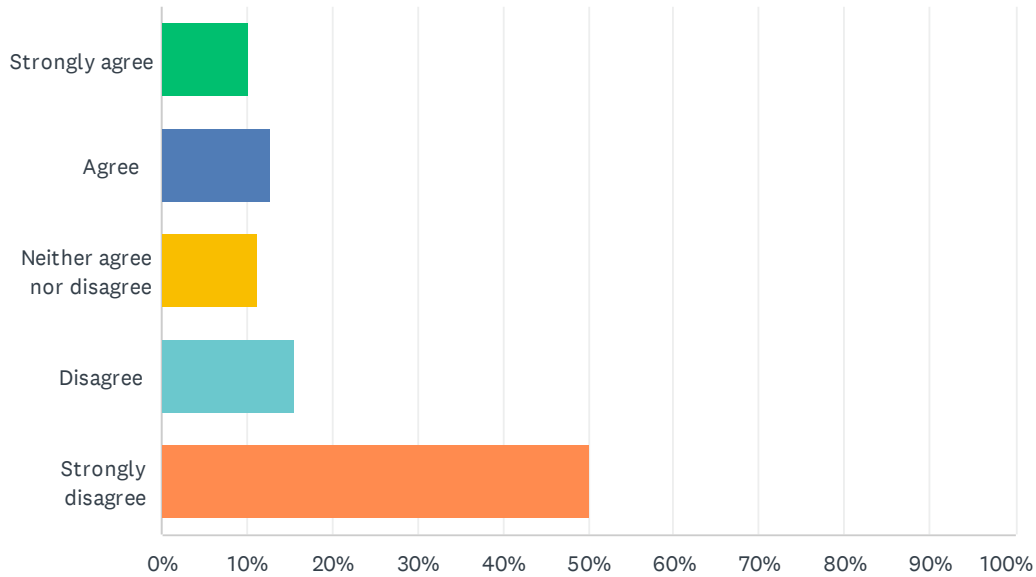

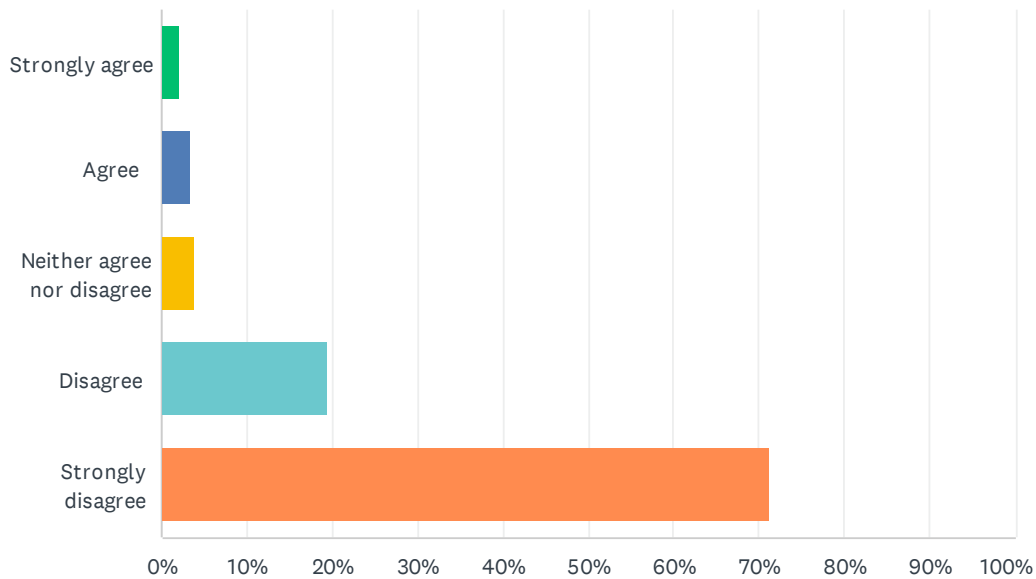

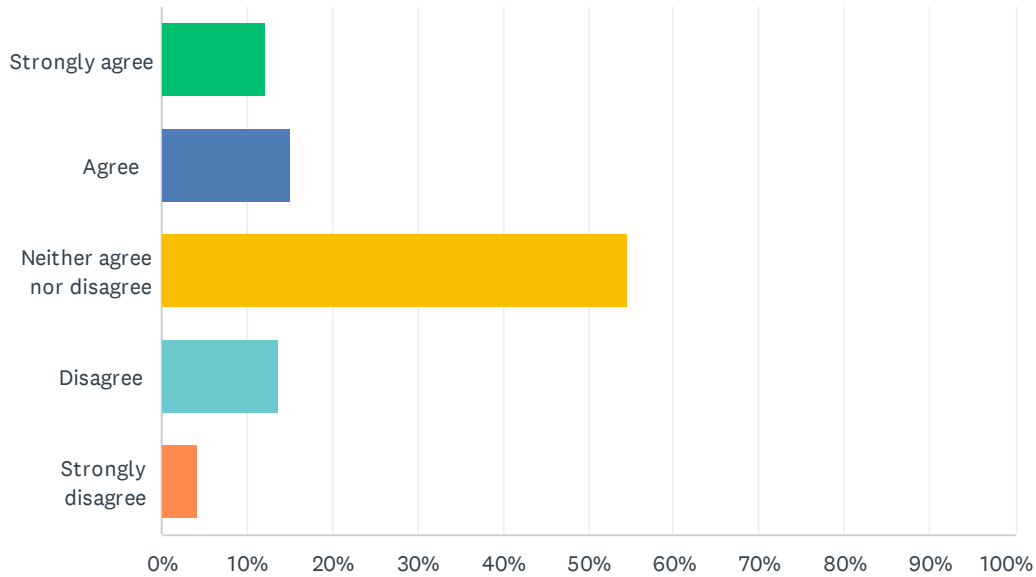

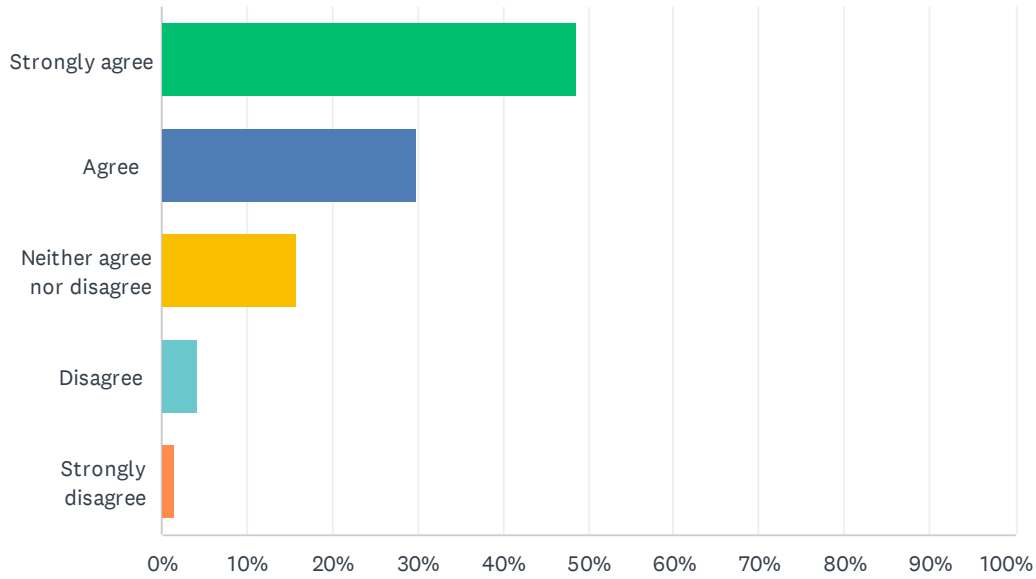

## Q9 I am concerned with the increased amount of traffic on the township roadways.

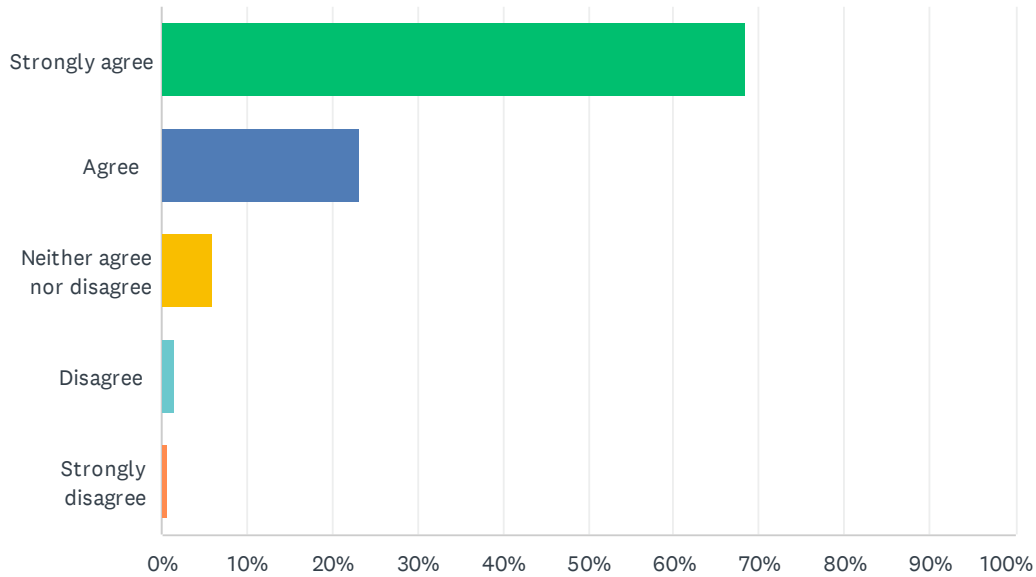

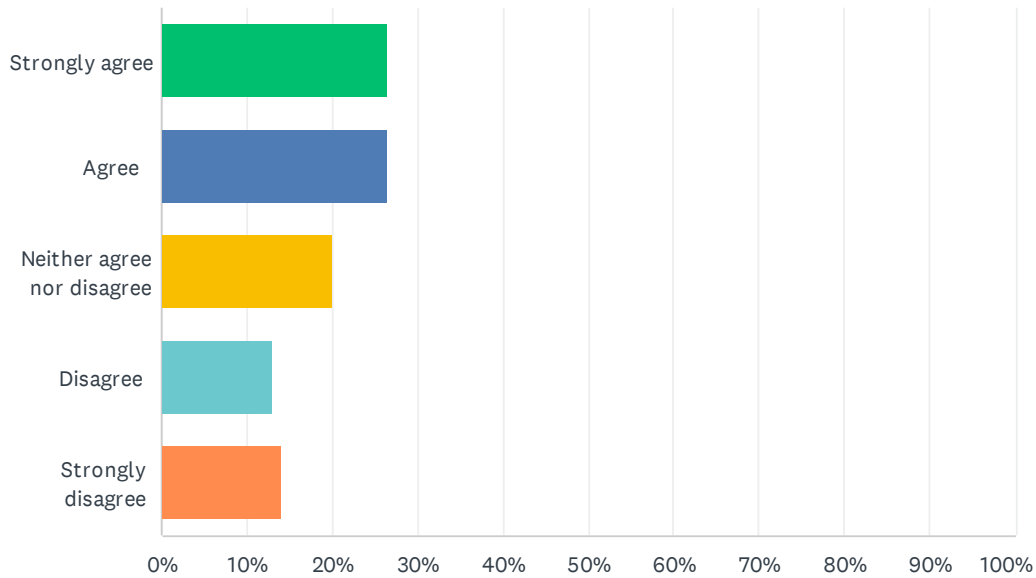

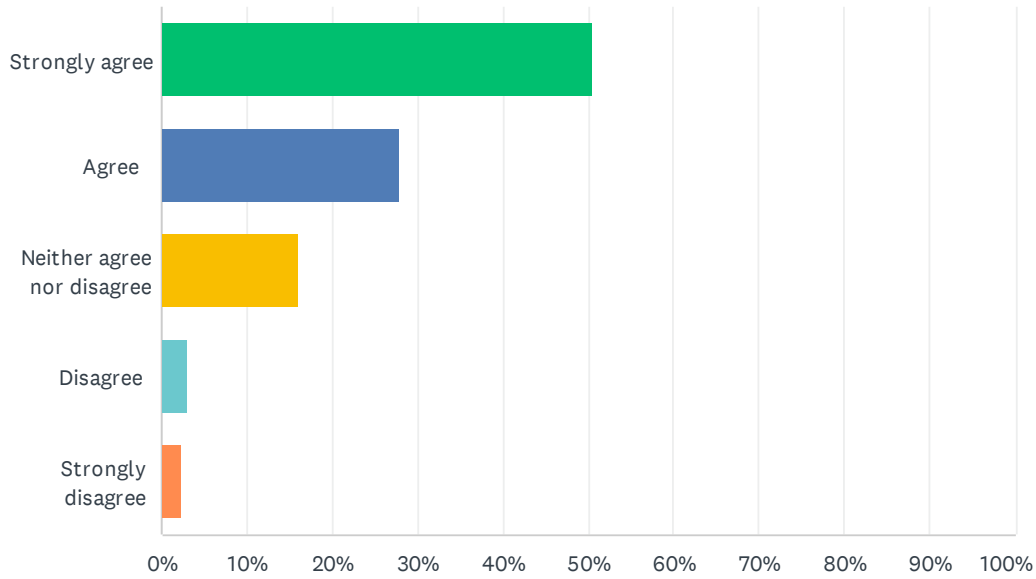

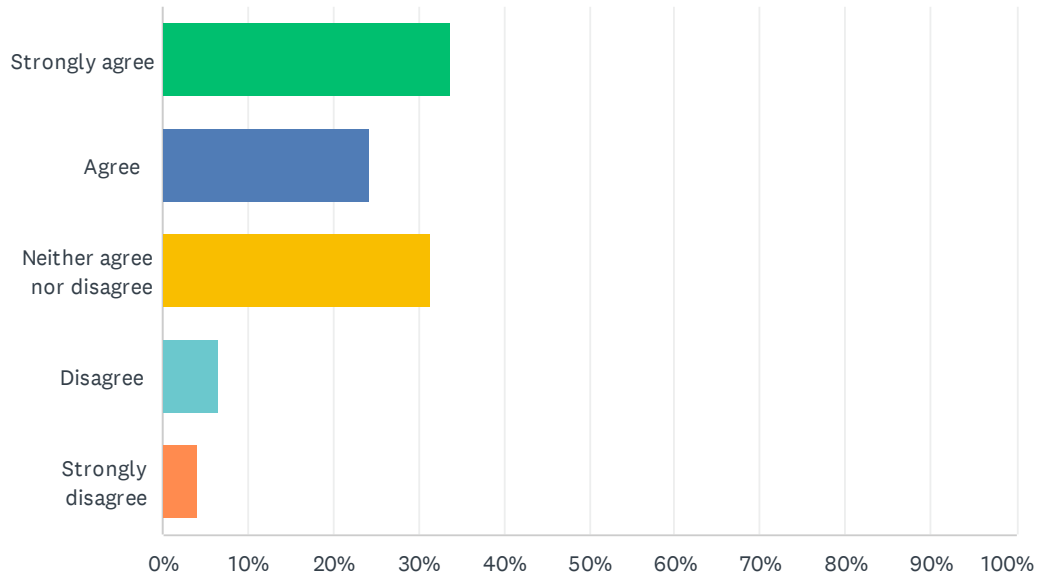

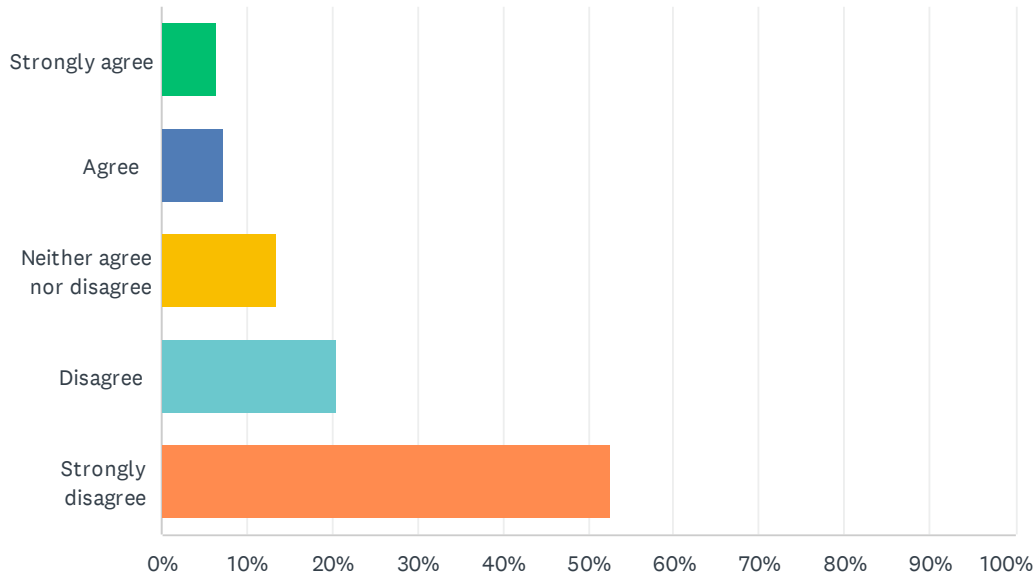

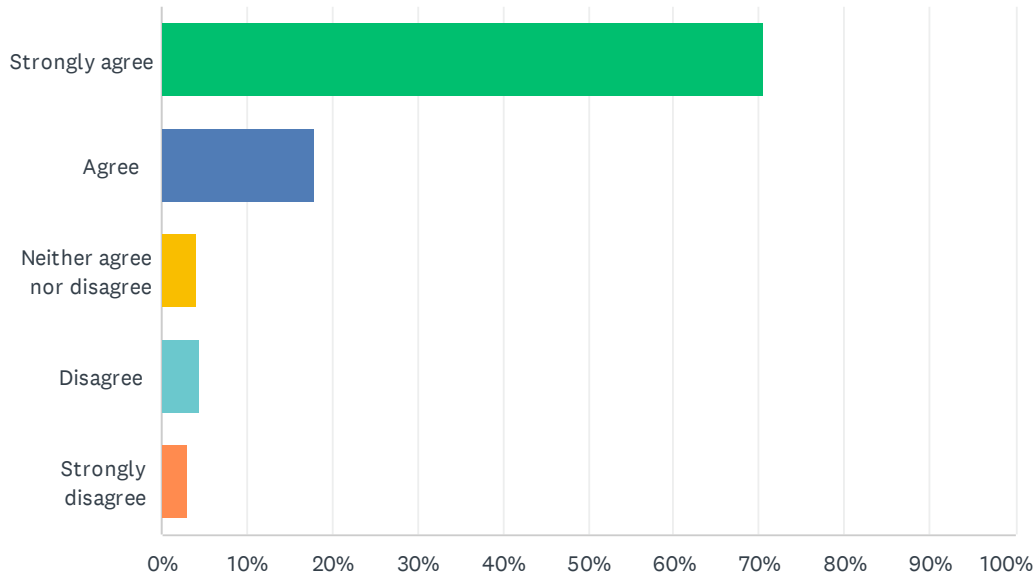

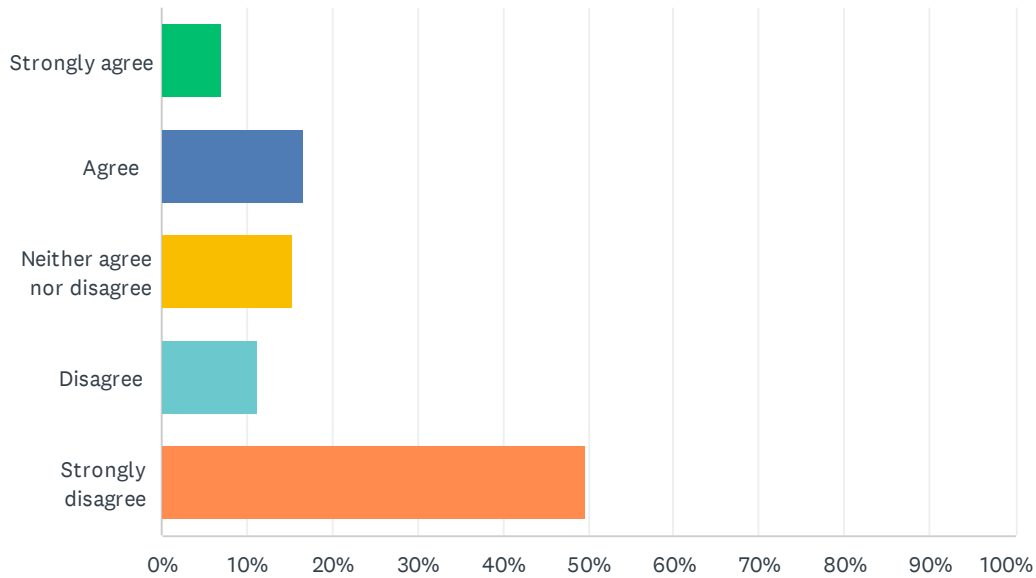
