The Plan strives for a cohesive and consistent trail system connecting local jurisdictions and the County's many wonderful features, including lakes, parks, historic areas, a world-class zoo and many other community resources, allowing for the enjoyment of all.



What is the plan?

- Identifies corridors throughout the County that would connect parks, schools, and activities;
- Collects existing trail, sidewalk, and park information;
- Honors existing local plans of individual communities;
- Provides a wall map and online detailed map to promote local support of trail construction.

What is the Trail Assistance Program?

An opportunity for communities and organizations to request funding from the Delaware County Commissioners for trail projects through grant applications. The review process is conducted by the Delaware County Trail Committee on behalf of the Commissioners.
