The Planning Process

The Delaware County Regional Planning Commission has begun working with Radnor Township on creating their first Comprehensive Plan. DCRPC and the Steering Committee will meet monthly for approximately 8 months to discuss resident survey results, the walk audit process, comprehensive plan chapters and more. Once a Comprehensive Plan has been adopted, the township intends on adopting and enforcing their own zoning code. Radnor Township zoning has historically been administered by Delaware County, with any variance, conditional use and appeal cases heard by the County's Board of Zoning Appeals.
